French designer Amaury Poudray has designed a glass, zeppelin-shaped aquarium supported by a steel frame. According to Poudray, his work involves the exploration of how structures are built and their limits through furniture design. "My goal was to elevate this glass shape and create a link between two materials. Glass is highlighted and in danger by the minimal steel legs. Several tries were necessary to find the solution of a glass tube to slide steel legs in. This object is a construction, an assembling, a simple accumulation of elements, alive or not. The construction principle is visible in the product conception as well as in its utilisation."

Amaury Poudray is also part of the new design studio "Matiere A" with Remi Bouhaniche and Marie Declerck whose aim is to develop furniture design, scenography and reflection about materials.
